



**ORDER ADOPTING BRIEFING
SCHEDULE**

ORDER SETTING HEARING

22 On September 16, 2022, Plaintiffs Shoshone-Paiute Tribes of the Duck Valley Indian
23 Reservation filed a complaint for injunctive and declaratory relief against the above-named Defendants.

24 On October 3, 2022, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss Plaintiff's complaint.


25 On October 5, 2022, Plaintiffs filed a motion for a mandatory/affirmative preliminary injunction
26 requiring Defendants to establish an early voting polling location on the Duck Valley Indian Reservation
27 in Owyhee, Nevada for two weeks prior to the general election from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. PST and on
28 election day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. PST.

1 On October 6, 2022, the court held a conference call with the attorneys for the parties. During the
2 call, the parties settled on a briefing schedule and a date for an evidentiary hearing and argument on the
3 motions.

4 **Therefore, the court enters the following orders:**

- 5 1. Each party shall file and serve a response to the other's motion by October 13, 2022, at 4:00 p.m.
6 PST.
- 7 2. Any reply briefs shall be filed and served by October 17, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. PST.
- 8 3. A hearing on the motion for a preliminary injunction and argument on the motion to dismiss is
9 set for October 18, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. PST in the courtroom of Department 2, Fourth Judicial
10 District Court. 4 hours shall be set aside for the hearing and argument.


