

On September 16, 2022, Plaintiffs Shoshone-Paiute Tribes of the Duck Valley Indian Reservation filed a complaint for injunctive and declaratory relief against the above-named Defendants. On October 3, 2022, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss Plaintiff's complaint.

On October 5, 2022, Plaintiffs filed a motion for a mandatory/affirmative preliminary injunction requiring Defendants to establish an early voting polling location on the Duck Valley Indian Reservation in Owyhee, Nevada for two weeks prior to the general election from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. PST and on election day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. PST.

On October 6, 2022, the court held a conference call with the attorneys for the parties. During the call, the parties settled on a briefing schedule and a date for an evidentiary hearing and argument on the motions.

Therefore, the court enters the following orders:

- 1. Each party shall file and serve a response to the other's motion by October 13, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. PST.
- 2. Any reply briefs shall be filed and served by October 17, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. PST.
- 3. A hearing on the motion for a preliminary injunction and argument on the motion to dismiss is set for October 18, 2022, at 1:00 p.m. PST in the courtroom of Department 2, Fourth Judicial District Court. 4 hours shall be set aside for the hearing and argument.
